Dear Friends of the Ohio Veterans' Memorial Park,

Thanks to all of you for the continued growth and popularity of The Ohio Veterans' Memorial Park (OVMP). Due to your continued support of the park, the addition of the permanent stage, and the upcoming memorial pavilion, we have been receiving an increasing amount of requests to use the park for a variety of services and events. We hope to honor as many of these requests as we can.

In order to avoid any confusion or interruption of events, we are asking for your cooperation in managing the park's schedule. Additionally, we are introducing a new procedure to ensure that we can provide all of the requested accommodations for your event.

Prior to scheduling an event at OVMP, we must ask that your organization, due to the nature of the memorial, understand and accept the following rules...

- 1. **Alcohol:** Alcohol is NOT permitted under any circumstance.
- 2. **Handicap Parking:** There are several handicap parking spaces available in the main parking lot. If additional parking spaces are required, please advise the park and we will designate additional handicap parking.
- 3. **Dates:** All reservation dates will be granted on a "First Come First Serve" basis. Please reserve your dates as far in advance as possible. We make every effort to post event dates on the website, however this does not mean that a specific date is available. Please contact us at (330) 773-2385 or info@ovmp.org to see if a date is available.
- 4. **Politics:** No political rallies or events are allowed. We do not support or endorse any political party or candidate. We do occasionally have politicians speaking at events; however any speeches must be related to our Heroes and void of any political agenda.
- 5. **Causes:** OVMP is available to all military-friendly organizations, military families and veterans. No anti-military rallies or events will be allowed or tolerated. (Please do not confuse our military with politics).
- 6. **Sound Ordinance:** Due to local regulations, all electronically-enhanced audio equipment must not begin prior to 6:00 am and cannot continue past 11:00 pm.
- 7. **Animals:** Animals are allowed at the park but must be restrained by leash or lead. We ask that you be courteous of other park guests and clean up after your pet.
- 8. **Bicycles:** We ask that no bikes are ridden nor walked inside of the memorial park. A bike rack is available to park bicycles next to the parking lot.
- 9. **Motorized Vehicles:** Please do not park or ride any motor vehicles (Motorized wheelchairs excluded) inside the memorial. Special permission may be granted upon request for photographic purposes. This must be arranged in advance.

### **Fee Information**

We do not typically charge a fee for using the park for your services. We ask that you consider making a donation to the park for construction and maintenance.

#### **Amenities**

We have several amenities available for your use and typically supply these at no charge. These include...

- 75 folding chairs / 20 folding tables
- Speaker podium / Sound system
- 2 folding gazebos
- 1 large tent (Additional large tents may be available)
- Stage

• 110v Electric outlets

- Coffee pots
- Coolers
- 2 Picnic tables
- TV / DVD player

If you have other items that you need, let us know and we will try to help you find them. In addition to these items, we can also assist you in arranging the following...

• Color Guard

- National Anthem Singer
- 21 Gun Salute

Honor Guard

• Pastor, Priest or Chaplain

Taps player

(Please note: We cannot guarantee that we will be able to provide these services as individuals are all volunteers. We will have to confirm their availability on a case-by-case basis)

## Sound System / TV

We have a small sound system, television and DVD player available for your use at the park. It is available on an "if available" basis.

## **Parking**

There is a small paved parking lot at the memorial that can accommodate roughly 30 vehicles. Additional parking is available in two large fields to the north and east of the memorial. If the fields are needed, we will try to provide personnel to assist with parking.

#### **Indemnification**

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the reservation holder shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless The Ohio Veterans' Memorial Park, The Village Of Clinton and The Clinton Cemetery Board; its officers, volunteers and employees from and against claims, damages, losses and expenses, including, but not limited to, attorney's fees, arising out of the acts or omissions of the reservation holder, provided that such claim, damage, loss or expense is attributable to bodily injury, sickness, disease or death, or to injury due to or destruction of property including loss of use resulting there from, but only to the extent caused in whole or in part by the acts or omission of the reservation holder, its agents, guests or anyone directly or indirectly invited by them or anyone for whose acts they may be liable, regardless of whether or not such claim damage, loss or expense is caused in part by a party indemnified hereunder. Such obligation shall not be construed to negate, abridge or reduce other rights or obligations of indemnity which would otherwise exist as to a party or person described in this paragraph.

#### **Insurance**

Depending on the size and/or nature of your event, we may require you to show proof of insurance for the event.

#### Restroom

We have one Port-A-John with a hand-washing station on site. If additional facilities are required, you will need to make your own arrangements or we can assist you. There will be a rental fee for additional facilities.


